Discipline Defined:

The removal of a member from the church for unrepentant, rebellious, immoral sin to protect the church's purity, witness, and to hopefully lead the sinner to repentance and restoration by having to experience the consequences of broken fellowship and Satan's efforts to destroy his/her life.
