How It All Started: Joseph

Genesis 26

01 I. Joseph conceded his identity (v1-3)

TYOLOGY IN SCRIPTURE

"A type is a shadow cast on the pages of Old Testament history by a truth whose full embodiment or antitype is found in the New Testament revelation." -Wick Broomall

JOSEPH

- Joseph was a shepherd (37:2)
- Joseph was the beloved of his father (37:3)
- Joseph was hated by his brothers (37:4, 5, 8) because of:
 1. Jacob's special love for him
 2. His words (his prophecy)

JESUS

- Jesus is the Good Shepherd (Jn 10:11)
- Jesus is the beloved of the Father (Matthew 3:17)
- Jesus was hated by His brothers (John 15:25; Luke 19:14) because:
 1. Jesus claimed God His Father
 2. His Words (John 7:7; 8:40)

JOSEPH

- Joseph suffered according to predetermined plan of God (45:5-7; 50:20)
- Joseph forgave and became a savior to his brothers (45:6-8)

JESUS

- Jesus suffered according to the plan of God (Acts 2:23; 3:12-18; Ephesians 3:11)
- Jesus forgave and saved all sinners (Acts 5:31)

JOSEPH

- Joseph told his brothers to bring his father to him (45:9)
- Joseph comforted those who betrayed him (45:14-15)

JESUS

- Jesus told his disciples the only way to his father was through him (John 14:6)
- Jesus comforted the disciples who abandoned him at the cross (John 20:19)
