### 6 Statements

- A woman <u>Physically</u> is an adult female made in the image of God. - Isaiah 66:13
- 2. A woman <u>Spiritually</u> is a sinner in need of salvation which is fully available to her through faith in Christ.
  Galatians 3:28
- 3. A woman <u>Sexually</u> is uniquely made to either live a life of singleness and celibacy or commit her life to a man in covenant marriage. - Genesis 2:24
- A woman <u>Maternally</u> is wonderfully designed to nurture as a mother. -Genesis 2:24, Song of Solomon 4:10
- 5. A woman Missionally in Christ is expected and equipped to strengthen the church and make the gospel known.
- 6. A woman <u>Relationally</u> is to bless other women and be respected, cherished, and protected by men. Titus 2:3-4, Proverbs 31:30-31
