The Reason

"building up", "all may learn", "all my be encouraged"

The Root

"The Character of God should be reflected in our worship, always."

Two Unhealthy Extremes:

- 1. All women in all worship services must remain silent at all times.
- 2. This verse is either not original or not applicable outside of Corinth.

1 Corinthians 11:5 (ESV)

5 but every wife who prays or prophesies with her head uncovered dishonors her head, since it is the same as if her head were shaven.

Titus 2:3 (ESV)
2 Timothy 1:5 (ESV)
Acts 18:26 (ESV)

Two Unhealthy Extremes:

- 1. All women in all worship services must remain silent at all times.
- 2. This verse is either not original or not applicable outside of Corinth.

God's order for human relationships in the family carry over in the church.

3 final words on this matter:

- 1. The gifts of girls and woman ought to be celebrated and appreciated
- 2. The command to be silent at certain times is not just for women (v.28, 30)
- 3. There is a challenge here to husbands often neglected
