1. A people and a place (v.1-7)
 - a. Genesis 46:8
 - b. Acts 7:1-19
 - c. Genesis 12:2
2. The Principle Problem (v. 8-10)
 - a. Forgetting the faithfulness of God is the root of many of our problems.
3. Pain and Persecution (v. 11-19)
 - a. Before we ever meet Moses, there were two faithful women whose names have been kept alive in the scriptures.
 - b. "To gear God does not mean being afraid of him in general but being afraid of the consequences of disobeying him."
4. Protection and Prosperity (v.20-22)
 - a. "God is always doing 10,000 things in your life, and you may be aware of 3 of them." - John Piper

There is perhaps no better way to begin this journey than by praying for those who are beginning their own.
